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**CAMPUS MINISTER INTERN APPLICATION ESSAYS**

We wish to hear more about you and your life experience. Your candid answers to the following questions will help both you and the Catholic Diocese of Richmond examine your readiness to make the commitment to our college campus ministry programs and to carry out effective ministry. **Essay responses should be single-sided, typed in 12-point, Times New Roman font, using 1 inch margins, and 1-1/2 spaced lines.** Please be sure to include your name and the title of the essay on each page of each document.

**Essay A: Autobiography (write 2 – 4 pages)**

Please complete a personal brief autobiography, which includes information about the following:

- Persons and experiences that helped shape who you are today: your personality, beliefs, and ideals.
- The biggest challenge you and your family have faced and how you worked through it.
- A difficult choice you have had to make, your process in approaching the decision, and how your decision reflected your values.
- The strengths and weaknesses of your personality and how you have seen them affect your relationships.
- Three specific strengths and weakness you possess with relating with people.
- Your passions and how you act on them.
- Other than church-related activities, what are your hobbies and interests.
- What do you plan on doing 10 years from now?

**Essay B: Personal Life and Faith (1-2 pages)**

- Briefly describe how and when it was that you came to know Jesus in a more personal way.
- Give solid examples of how your life has changed through your relationship with Jesus.
- Describe your prayer life.
- What part does God and prayer play in your family life?

**Essay C: Catholicism (1 -2 pages)**

- How do you describe your own experience with the Eucharist?
- What do you value most about the Catholic faith?
- What teachings of the Catholic Church do you find most difficult to embrace and why?
- What are some things you would like to learn about the Catholic Church?

**Essay D: Internship and Campus Ministry (1-2 pages)**

- What is the purpose of campus ministry?
- Why are you interested in serving in an internship program?
- Describe the impact that you can have on a campus ministry program.
- How do you see that living as a campus ministry intern will transform you?
